Why \$9 a box?

Many people want to know why OCC asks for a \$9 donation for each shoebox. A great deal comes from that \$9:

- 1. All transportation for the box from the Charlotte processing plant to the receiving country is paid for by those funds.... That includes planes, boats (and some boxes travel for weeks by boat), and anything else it takes to get the box into a child's hands.
- 2. Each shoebox gets a beautiful booklet called "The Greatest Gift" printed in the child's native language. The \$9 helps pay for translating and printing costs.
- 3. Every time OCC has a shoebox distribution, the Gospel is presented beautifully with a written script and large pictures, all funded through the \$9. Also, the expense of training those who present the Gospel comes from the \$9.
- 4. If there are customs charges for boxes coming into receiving countries, it is covered by the \$9.

When you consider how much is done with the donation, \$9 doesn't seem like that much!! If you would like to donate funds to cover these items, please see Judy Edwards. Thank you!!

THE JOURNEY—BECOMING A DISCIPLE


